ADMISSION TO CANDIDACY EXAMINATION COMMITTEE - Ph.D.

The Admission to Candidacy Examination Committee will consist of a minimum of 3 graduate faculty in the student's program, and two external members outside of the program of study or Track. One of these external members should be from a pool of faculty approved by CGS to ensure fairness and equity in the qualifying examination process. The choice of this CGS faculty member will be by the mentor to ensure appropriate scientific balance and diversity of scientific expertise. This faculty member is also charged with ensuring that all students are treated fairly and equitably across the different exams. Only members of the Graduate Faculty may serve on the Admission to Candidacy Examination Committee. Committee membership should receive final approval by the student's Graduate Coordinator and forwarded to the Dean by the end of January. Please note that the composition of the student's Dissertation Committee may differ from the Admission to Candidacy Examination Committee.
