BIOCHEMISTRY AND MOLECULAR BIOLOGY WRITTEN EXAMINATION

The written examination consists of two documents that are graded by the Student's Dissertation Advisory Committee: (1) a fully referenced literature review, and (2) a research proposal based on the Student's proposed dissertation project. Both documents will be submitted to the Student's Committee at least two weeks before the proposal defense to give them adequate time to review. The research proposal is scored by each member of the Dissertation Advisory Committee, with an average score of 70% or above required to pass. The literature review is scored pass/fail, and a passing grade is required by at least 4 members of the Committee. The Committee should provide written feedback to the Student, describing both the strengths and weaknesses of each document.
