

CBI Faculty Membership Policy

Consistent with the mission of the CBI to expand and develop the use of imaging in biomedical research at MUSC, CBI Faculty members are comprised of faculty from all Colleges of MUSC (Assistant, Associate or full Professor) who have experience in the development and/or application of MRI methods in their research. Collaboration among faculty in the development of new and cross-disciplinary imaging methodologies is strongly encouraged. Faculty members are also expected to attend CBI seminars, take part in Town Hall meetings, share their expertise with the MUSC community, and generally support the overall well-being of the CBI. If asked, each faculty member is expected give a lecture to the CBI every other year on their imaging-oriented research. Appointment as CBI faculty is contingent upon continued participation in CBI activities and will be reviewed periodically by the CBI leadership.

Appointment

CBI faculty members are appointed by a majority vote of the existing CBI faculty. The vote is made following a seminar given by the prospective member on their imaging research and how it contributes to the development of biomedical imaging, either clinically, preclinically, or methodologically.
