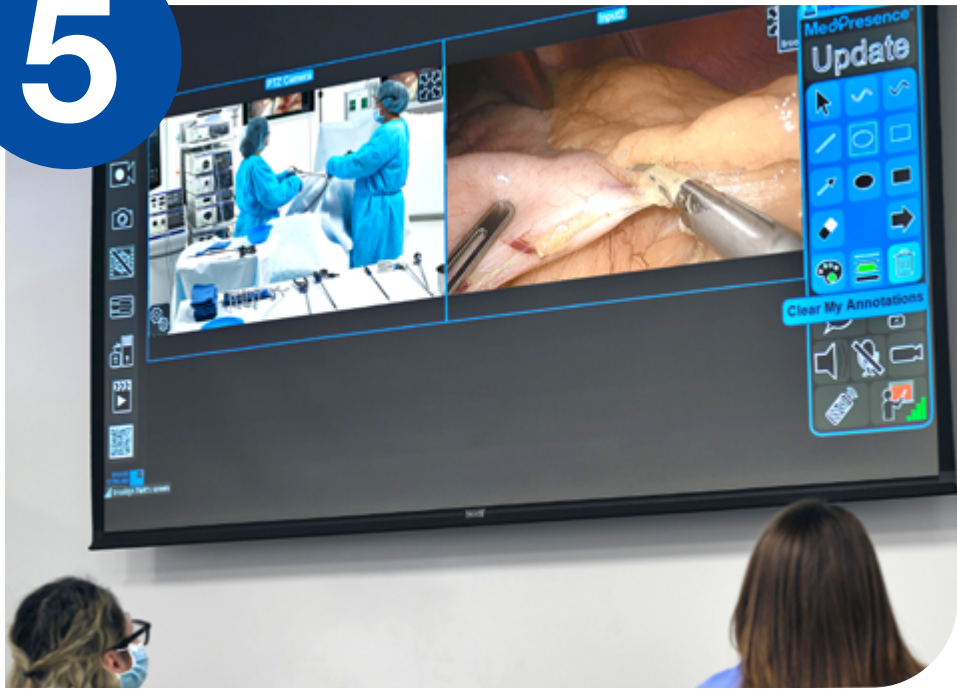
Allow students to see what you are visualizing in the clinical classroom
