- 4. Two reference letters: Senior advisor or certified community agent and attending Physician
- 5. Document verifying graduation status or copy of original High School Equivalency or General Equivalency (GED)

DEADLINES: There is one award. Entry with supporting documents and a 5x7 color photograph must be mailed as a package by August 31st for fall semester or December 1st for spring semester.
