A Message from the Director

Over the last year the Department of Radiology and Radiological Science had continued growth in all aspects of its mission. In addition to 5 sites of operation on campus we now provide full imaging services at MUSC-P West Ashley at the Citadel Mall, the recently opened Shawn Jenkins Children's Hospital, and the Summey Pavilion in North Charleston. Growth in CT and MR services had contributed to a 6% annualized increase in RVU activities up until March 2020. In April we suffered short-term setbacks due to Covid-19, but patient volumes have recently improved significantly. We expect our RVU volume to exceed 310,000 this year.

Mike Ricciardone retired last December after 7 years of outstanding service, and in February we were fortunate to hire Ron McKee from Johns Hopkins University as Radiology Administrator.

Over the last year we recruited several new faculty to key positions including Thoracic (Dr. Dhiraj Baruah), Nuclear Medicine (Dr. Saeed Elojeimy), Body (Dr. Nicholas Shaheen), Musculoskeletal (Dr. Cody Quirk) and Neuroradiology (Drs. Eric Bass and Justin Chetta). Due to the retirement of Dr. Claudio Schonholz we are currently actively recruiting a VIR faculty member. We currently have a subspecialty group of 45 outstanding faculty members.

The Radiology Residency Program continues to be well sought after as it provides excellent training under the direction of Dr. Madelene Lewis and Dr. Seth Stalcup.

After 16 years' service as Professor and Chairman of Radiology I decided earlier this year to step down, intending to work part time in the Thoracic Radiology section. Over the last 6 months a national search has been conducted by the Dean's office, and an announcement from Dean Dubois of the new Chair is anticipated shortly.

This year has presented many unusual challenges to us all, but our staff, residents, and faculty are resilient and remain dedicated to excellent patient care, education and research.

I hope you are all doing well, and I would like to send you and your families my best wishes for a brighter future.


