

THIRD YEAR SURGERY COURSE

CARDIOTHORACIC SURGERY ROTATION

OBJECTIVE:

To develop an understanding of basic surgical principles through participation in the care of patients with diseases of the heart, lungs, and esophagus.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Follow guidelines as outlined in the Intern Guide from the CT Knowledge Book provided.
2. Adhere to the overall guidelines for the third year surgery course.
3. Make daily morning ward rounds with residents beginning at 5:30 a.m. in CTICU. If not assigned to OR, participate in ward duties as directed.
4. Read "The Patient Encounter" and attend the required Clinical Skills H&P evaluation session to be scheduled with Dr. Castillo-Sang. Perform workup (history and physical exam) on assigned patients – limit three/week and review with CT resident.
5. Prepare for the assigned operative procedure by examining the patient or reviewing the clinic chart beforehand, reviewing relevant laboratory and imaging studies, and discussing the patient with the assigned resident and attending surgeon.
6. Participate in assigned CT operative procedures (be on time – surgery begins 0730 Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday; 0830 Tuesday).
7. Follow assigned patients in the CTICU and on 4-East and write daily progress notes in SOAP format. These notes should be countersigned by service resident or attending.
8. Make rounds with attending physician as permitted by your other responsibilities.
9. Attend out-patient clinics with residents/attendings at least twice during rotation and otherwise as schedule permits.
10. Attend small group sessions.
11. Attend any student lectures scheduled by CT Surgery attending physicians.
Note: Student lectures can be rescheduled so as not to conflict with small group sessions.
12. Attend CT specific conference(s) listed below.
13. Attend conferences required of all students on third year rotation.
14. Schedule Midpoint feedback meetings on time with chief resident or attending physician (first); then Dr. Ikonomidis (call Nina Johnson-West at 6-4842 to schedule Dr. Ikonomidis).
