## **HEMATURIA**

## **General Principles**

Confirm the hematuria R/O external source Never Rx with antibiotics without culture Urine cytology of questionable value

## **Etiology**

Infection Neoplasm Urolithiasis

Renal parenchymal disease Various forms of nephritis

Collagen diseases
Diabetic nephropathy

Usually have some degree of renal insufficiency and/or proteinuria

Trauma

Congenital anomalies

Miscellaneous Coagulopathies

Anticoagulant overdose

Sickle cell trait

Idiopathic

## **Evaluation**

History Nature of bleeding: gross or microscopic; initial, terminal, total

Associated symptoms: pain, bladder sx, etc.

Constitutional symptoms: weight loss, fever, night sweats, etc.

Physical

**Imaging**IVP

CT

Ultrasound

MRI

Retrograde pyelograms

**Endoscopy** Cystoscopy

Ureteroscopy

Other Culture/sensitivity

Cytology Renal biopsy
