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#### **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

- Recognize the difference between primary immune deficiency and primary immune regulatory disorders
- Identify key clinical red flags for inborn errors of immunity and know when and how to initiate initial immune evaluation
- Interpret a basic immune laboratory evaluation and know when to refer to immunology
- Identify clinical domain approach to comprehensive evaluation and management of psoriatic arthritis (PsA)
- Incorporate quantification of remission and low disease activity as target of treatment for PsA
- Describe key efficacy and safety data on different MOAs of current and emerging therapies for PsA to your patient for shared management decision making
- Collaborate with and educate referral sources for early identification and referral of axial spondyloarthritis

- Identify patients who may benefit from the addition of a calcineurin inhibitor to standard-of-care therapy for LN
- Identify patients who may benefit from the addition of belimumab to standard-of-care therapy for LN
- Decide when to add a newly approved drug for LN when treating patients
- Decide if a treated LN patient is in remission
- Decide when to withdraw immunosuppression in LN patients
- Assess risk of relapse of LN


