

CARDIOTHORACIC ANESTHESIA AND PERIOPERATIVE MEDICINE

SCOPE OF PRACTICE PGY-5

- Under the supervision of a staff Anesthesiologist, responsible for providing care for patients undergoing surgery for thoracic and cardiac procedures.
- Delivers anesthesia (general, neuraxial, regional, and/or monitored anesthesia care) to a broad patient population undergoing a variety of operative or anesthetic procedures under the supervision of the attending anesthesiologist.
- Supervises PGY2-4 anesthesiology residents under the direction of the attending anesthesiologist.
- Participates in resident teaching and evaluation.
- Participates in call coverage for fellow-level cardiac and thoracic cases.
- Participates in medical student teaching and evaluation.
- Assists in the coordination of division specific education conferences.
- Performs moderate sedation.
