Sept	Neurological Surgery	The Society of Neurological Surgeons has issued a policy on interviews for their application cycle. Sept	Orthopaedic Surgery	For letters of recommendation to orthopaedic surgery residency applications, the American Orthopaedic Association's (AOA) Council of Orthopaedic Residency Directors (CORD) requests an Electronic Standardized Letter of Recommendation (eSLOR) as a replacement for a traditional narrative letter of recommendation. A separate written letter of recommendation is not necessary if utilizing the eSLOR.			



Sept	Otolaryngology - Head and Neck Surgery	After sending the request form to your author(s), visit the eSLOR Applicant page on the AOA website. You must first sign an agreement and enter your ERAS AAMC ID before letter author(s) can begin an eSLOR.  Applicants interested in pursuing Otolaryngology have the option to participate in a preference signaling system.  Signaling provides a clear, reliable method to demonstrate sincere interest to programs and may improve the likelihood of an interview offer. Applicants are advised to consult with their Designated Dean's Office (DDO) and
