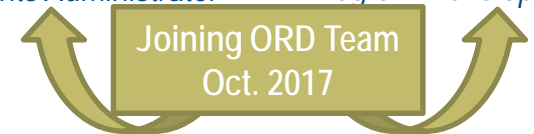

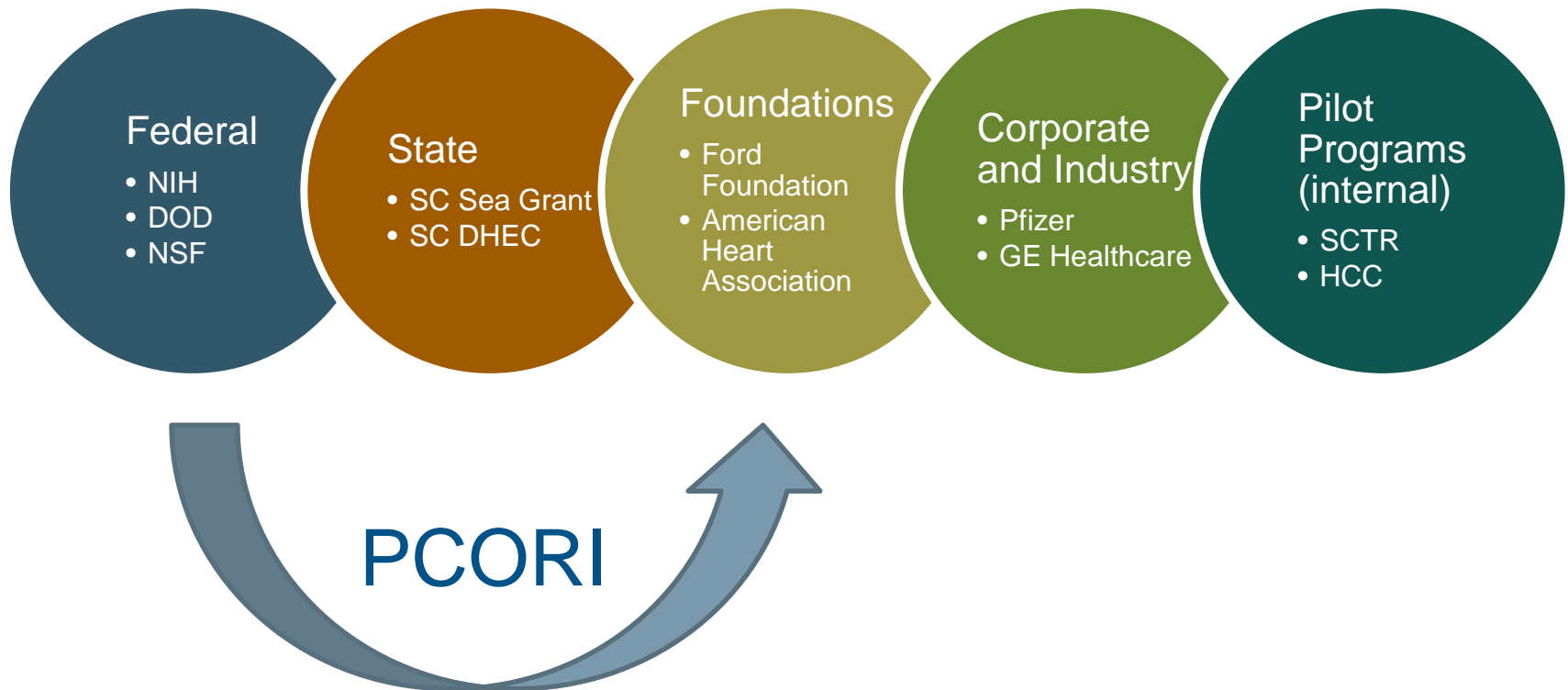

- Signup for Research Funding Alerts (RFAs)



Grants.gov

- Centralized, online process to find & apply for over 900 grant programs from 26 federal agencies
- Browse by category, agency, or eligibility criteria



Grant Forward

- Paid subscription web-based service – **NEW**
- Creates account to save searches and receive personalized grant recommendations

- The most comprehensive database for private and public foundations
- Sign up for RFPs to receive funding notices

NIH Clinical Trial-Specific Funding Opportunities

Effective for due dates
on or after Jan 25,
2018

- NIH will require that all applications involving one or more clinical trials be submitted through a FOA specifically designed for clinical trials

All existing FOAs will
be updated in Fall 2017

- FOAs will specify the allowability of clinical trials in *Section II. Award Information*
- New FOAs will specify allowability of clinical trials in the FOA title
- FOAs that accept clinical trials will incorporate specific review criteria to ensure that reviewers appropriately consider clinical trial-related information
