Priorities in creating evaluations

- 1. Evaluation planning should begin during course or curriculum building (not at the end).
 - Help to really think about what the course or curriculum is all about, including goals, objectives, and how it will meet those goals. (You will collect the right data).
 - Ensuring an evaluation plan can be carried out at the end of the program
 - You can take measures before and after



Priorities in creating evaluations

2. Know the evaluations questions that are required to be asked prior to building the course and curriculum.

 - Course
 - Educator
- LCME Questions
 - Organization of the course
 - Workload
 - Midpoint feedback

Pros and Cons of Surveys/Questionnaires as Evaluations

• Pros

- Anonymous
- Inexpensive
- Easy to compare and analyze
- Administer to a large class
- Gain lots of data in short time
- Many vetted questionnaires exist or are requested

Cons

- Might not get careful feedback
- Wording of questions can bias responses
- Impersonal
- May need sampling expert
- Does not get the full story



Priorities in creating evaluations

3. Timing of Evaluations (Critical)

- Do not send out evaluations too early or too late
 - Could skew data or hinder collection
- Ensure evaluations are collected prior to grade being given
- Student Responsibility Policy (COM webpage)
 - Preclerkship students have one week
 - Clinical students have 2 weeks to complete evaluations

MedHub is a web-based application designed to house, document, track and monitor UME requirements and educational experiences. This system will allow you to review schedules, complete evaluations, create your own scholarly activity portfolio, review conferences, etc.

If you have been identified as a Program Director or a Course/Clerkship Director, you have the ability to review specific information related to a resident or student including his/her individual performance evaluations, conference attendance, procedure logs, and learning portfolios. You will also be able to review aggregate data of faculty and program/course evaluations.

- Documenting required clinical encounters




Portfolios

You have the ability to manage and track your own portfolio information. Faculty who are identified as Mentors or Program Directors can also view portfolios of the residents and faculty who are identified as Course Directors or Student Advisors can view student portfolios.

Each portfolio entry option has its own specific fields related to that entry.

MedHub provides the ability for faculty to maintain a CV online as well!

•View an aggregate or summary information of evaluations that have been completed of you.



Course Objectives


The Course Objectives provides the student with the ability to review the course/clerkship objectives for the courses/clerkships that they have been enrolled under. Goes along with the extensive Curriculum Mapping.





Curriculum Mapping

Curriculum Mapping functionality allows, faculty, student and administration to search the curriculum map with any keywords. This shows sessions objectives, courses, lecturers, activities that this keyword would appear in. *April 15th Curriculum Mapping Talk at noon.*



Personal Calendar

You have the ability to keep a personal calendar in MedHub and sync it to either an Outlook e-mail account or through an iPhone or Android. By selecting the "View myCalendar" button, it will allow you to add any appointments, meetings, etc for each day within each month. If the program/course has created a conference schedule, these conferences will also appear on your personal calendar automatically.
